### **Acute decompensated heart failure: The cardiorenal syndrome**

CONSENSUS DEFINITION of the cardio-renal syndrome has not been established Many believe that it is the final manifestation of deteriorating renal function in the presence of heart failure Not much is understood about the patho-physiology of the cardiorenal syndrome An imbalance in interactions between the failing heart, neurohormonal systems

### **Heart and Kidney Interactions: what are the challenges for ...**

renal dysfunction suggest that renal congestion may be the primary driver of worsening renal function Once discharged after acute decompensated HF it is advisable to transition the patients into an outpatient dcompression clinic for further Decongestive therapy and follow-up Challenges

### **Musculoskeletal Pathway Referral Criteria and Triage ...**

cardio-renal toxicity and the person’s risk factors, including age 1-5 Gastroprotection NSAID use is associated with around a fourfold increase in the incidence of severe upper GI ulcer complications compared to non-users of NSAIDs Concomitant gastro-protective treatment is recommended for those with risk factors for GI adverse effects
